

After your 2 nights in Damaraland, fly to another camp born out of a community partnership, this time with the Himba people: Serra Cafema. Enjoy this brand-new camp, learn about the customs and traditions of the semi-nomadic Himba community in a respectful manner and lose yourself in one of the most remote corners of Africa!
