Cradled by the mighty Zambezi – that flows over the world-famous Victoria Falls – and Limpopo rivers, Zimbabwe is a land of beautiful vistas and incredible wildlife.

Our scenic and private areas include Hwange National Park, where our waterholes attract massive herds of elephant, buffalo and plains game – followed by their predators; and photogenic Mana Pools where the fast-flowing Zambezi attracts a myriad wildlife.

The grand finale takes place in Victoria Falls, where – after exploring the spectacular World Heritage Site – we connect with friends and other safari specialists, to gain first-hand knowledge from experts, exchange ideas and inspire each other in a two-day conservation workshop.

- **Chikwenya and Linkwasha camps:** all meals, twice-daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry and all local drinks; excludes premium imported brands and champagne
- **Toka Leya:** all meals, twice-daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry, a guided tour of the Zambian side of the Victoria Falls, a guided tour of Livingstone town and Livingstone Museum, sunset river cruise, visit to a local African village and all local drinks; excludes premium imported brands and champagne
- **Stanley and Livingstone Boutique Hotel:** breakfast, scheduled shared Victoria Falls Airport transfers and scheduled shared Victoria Falls town transfers – three transfers per day, VAT, government levies and emergency medical evacuation

DAY 1 & 2 **CHIKWENYA**

A photographer's paradise, Chikwenya overlooks an open floodplain and the broad Zambezi River, with a backdrop provided by the mountains of the Rift Valley Escarpment. Game is plentiful with large concentrations of buffalo and elephant, while predators such as lion, wild dog, leopard and cheetah are often sighted. In between a variety of activities, the camp's main area offers shady spaces to sit back and enjoy the spectacular scenery and passing wildlife. Activities include game drives, nature walks, boating and canoeing.

DAY 3 & 4 LINKWASHA



Situated in one of the most game-rich areas in Hwange, with access to the famed Ngamo Plains, Linkwasha offers a luxurious and exclusive safari experience. The camp's fresh contemporary design echoes the wide-open vistas around it, with multi-tier platforms providing a range of vantage points from which to enjoy the continuous parade of wildlife at the neighbouring pan, where herds of elephant and an assortment of plains game, including giraffe, buffalo and zebra, come to drink and bathe. DAY 5 TOKA LEYA

A safari-style sanctuary situated on the banks of the Zambezi River, Toka Leya provides a peaceful wilderness experience just 12 km upstream from the Victoria Falls. With luxurious outdoor baths, a wellness centre complete with yoga/meditation deck and a private veranda overlooking the rushing, roaring river, there is ample space to relax, participate in the camp's tree rehabilitation initiative – or set off on one of the many adventurous activities we have on offer, including visiting the Falls, Livingstone town, Livingstone Museum and a local African village, as well as a gorgeous sunset river cruise.
