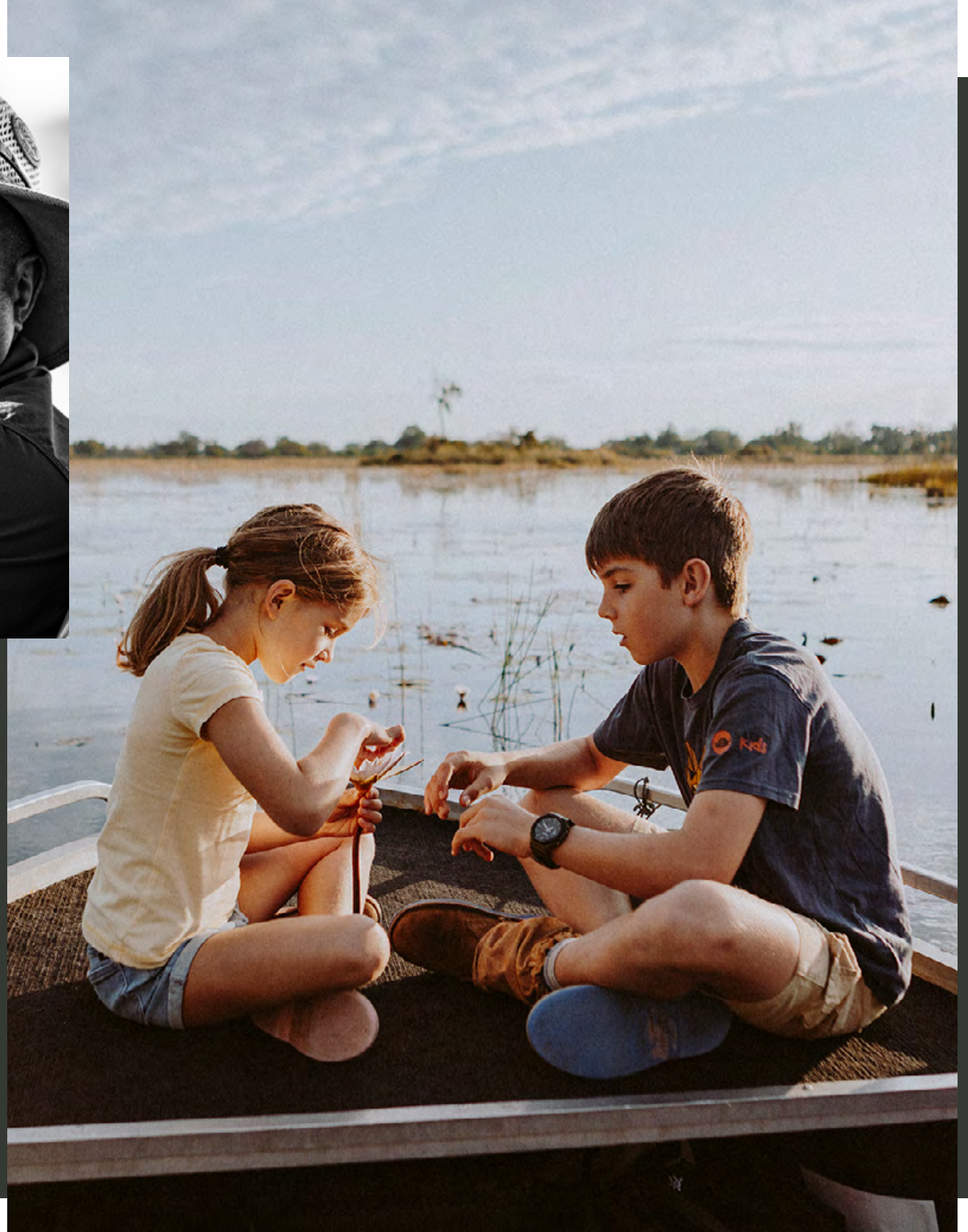




## ADVENTURES FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY

The following discounts apply for children up to and including 16 years old, if sharing with an adult in family accommodation – or in a standard room where a family room is not available:

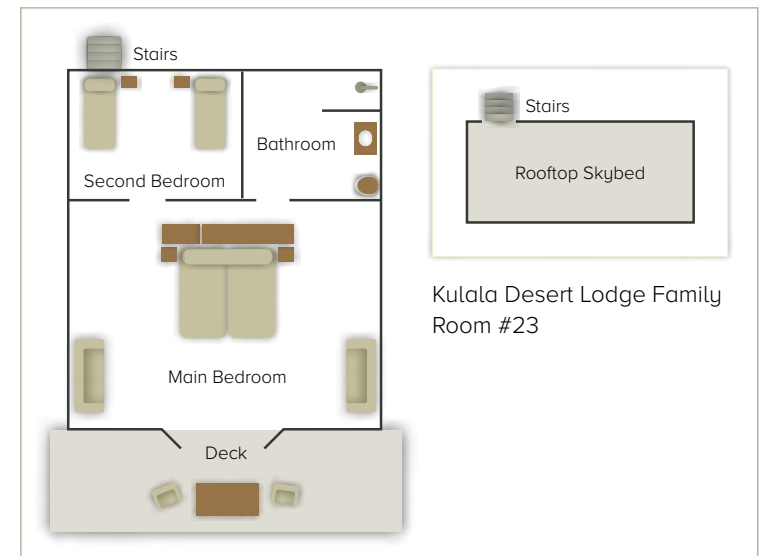
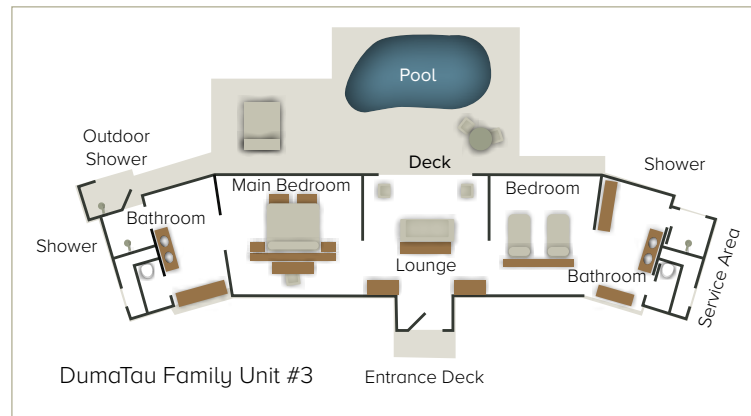
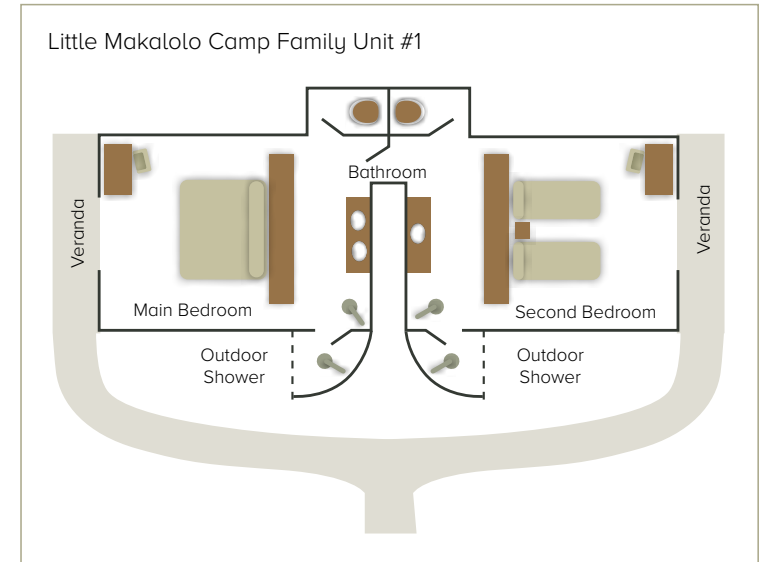
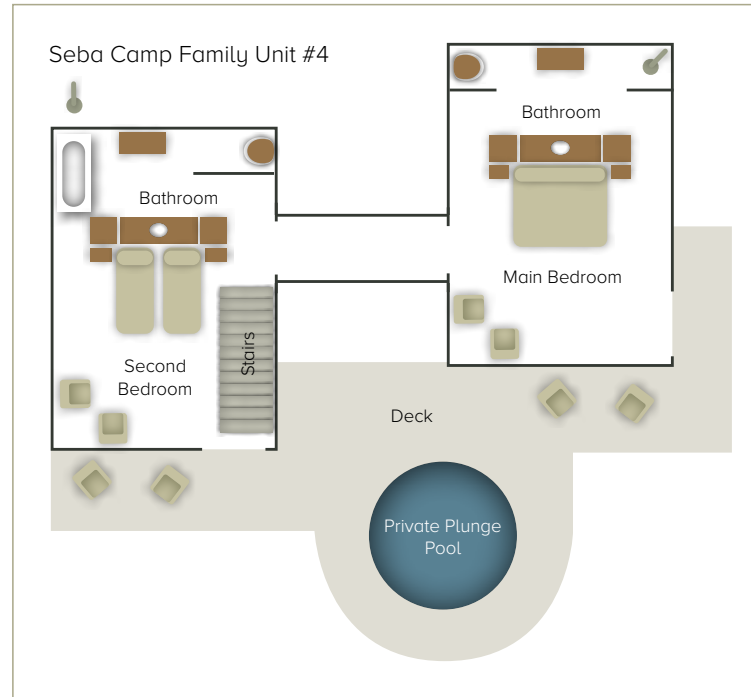
- 35% discount from 1 June to 31 October, as well as during the festive period (20 December to 5 January)
