

GETTING AROUND

The flights listed in the grid below are as per the current operational schedules of both Wilderness Air and Proflight. Should you find there are restrictions regarding times and days of the week, we are pleased to advise that a sole-use charter option is possible – any day of the week, subject to availability. Based on a 4-seater aircraft, costs for 2019 are as follows:

US\$ 2200 nett, one way — Lusaka to the Busanga Plains and vice versa

Our recommendation is to include a 2 night stop-over at Toka Leya and enjoy the magnificent Victoria Falls, a cultural visit to one of the nearby villages, river cruises, rhino tracking, etc. before continuing with your Busanga Plains adventure.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY - WHAT AN ADVENTURE!

- Fly into Victoria Falls or Livingstone and spend 2 nights or more at **Toka Leya**. Staying at Toka Leya offers an introduction to the Zambezi River, the Victoria Falls, cruises, adrenalin activities, spa treatments, and rhino tracking.
- Fly from Livingstone to Busanga Plains (approximately 2 hours) situated in Kafue National Park, for 3 nights at **Shumba** or **Busanga Bush Camp**. Enjoy remote and vast plains, herds of lechwe and puku, hippos, lions, wonderful birding and the more unusual antelope like roan, sable and oribi. Activities on offer during your 3-night stay are day and night game drives, plus hot air ballooning in August, September and October (where a conservation fee of \$200 per person will be charged in camp for this breathtaking experience).
- Fly to Lusaka from the Busanga Plains (approximately 1 hour). The journey continues with a 2- to 3-hour road transfer in an air-conditioned vehicle through the countryside to Chirundu. After clearing Zambian and Zimbabwean customs and immigration, there is another short road transfer to the Zambezi River. Embark on a speed boat trip down the Zambezi River (approximately 1 hour) to Mana Pools for a 3-night stay at either **Ruckomechi** or **Little Ruckomechi**. One of Africa's most beautiful national parks, Mana Pools offers spectacular views of the Zambezi River and the Zambian escarpment, as well as large numbers of elephant in the dry months; other wildlife includes lion, leopard and hippo.
- Fly from Mana Pools to Harare for onward arrangements.

Notes:

- 1. A combination of Lower Zambezi and Mana Pools National Park is not recommended due to logistical and cost implications. In addition Lower Zambezi and Mana Pools national parks offer very similar experiences.
- 2. Wilderness Air Zambia offers a short 10-minute hop between Ruckomechi/Little Ruckomechi and Chikwenya. Although the camps offer the same activities, the habitats are very different, and the combination enhances guests' overall Mana Pools experience. It is not possible to link Ruckomechi and Chikwenya via boat or road transfer, only via air.
- 3. To use the layover time for some of the Wilderness Air and Proflight flights productively, an option to book a short Lusaka city tour with lunch is available.
