Wilderness Explorations looks forward to hosting you at Linyanti Tented Camp, on the banks of the Linyanti River, for a thrilling safari and informative photographic workshop with renowned photographer Dana Allen.

Entertaining daily sessions with Dana include lectures and in-field tuition on composition techniques, how to get those winning shots, anticipating wildlife behaviour together with dynamic Adobe Lightroom workflow and colour correction techniques*. Those who would like to can also submit images for critique.

Linyanti Tented Camp is set in the 125 000-hectare Linyanti Concession bordering Chobe National Park, and is the ideal base from which to explore this wildlife-rich area. Unrivalled in its remoteness and the sense of space that it affords, the concession is bordered by two iconic watercourses – the Linyanti River to the north and the sporadic Savute Channel to the south. The eight tents are large, airy and designed to recreate the accommodation style of the early explorers and the main area of the camp, built on a slightly raised deck, looks out over the Linyanti River and floodplain.

**Recommended equipment: A DSLR camera and a laptop, preferably with Lightroom installed*



ITINERARY | 10 to 14 November 2016

10 November

Arrive in Maun; transfer by light aircraft to Chobe Airstrip and then a 1.5 hour game drive transfer to Linyanti Tented Camp. After dinner Dana will brief you on the details of the workshop.

11 – 13 November

Game drives take place each morning. After brunch your images are downloaded and processed under the watchful eye of Dana. One-on-one questions and problem solving are addressed and discussed each afternoon after siesta before you head out for an afternoon game drive. A photographic presentation/lecture about photographic composition and wildlife behaviour takes place every evening after dinner.

14 November

A game drive will be followed by brunch; transfer by light aircraft back to Maun in time for your international flight back to Johannesburg.

We highly recommend 2 extra nights' stay at Xigera Camp or Pelo Camp after the workshop (at an additional cost).
