ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 1 – Depart O.R.Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg, South Africa, on your private charter. Clear immigration formalities in Windhoek before proceeding to Little Kulala at Sossusvlei for 2 nights.

Day 3 – Depart Little Kulala and travel via Swakopmund on the coast for a crayfish lunch before continuing to Hoanib Skeleton Coast in the Kaokoveld for 3 nights.

Day 6 – Clearing customs and immigration in both Ondangwa, Namibia and Maun, Botswana – travel by private charter from Hoanib Skeleton Coast to Vumbura Plains or similar in the Okavango Delta for 3 nights.

Day 9 – Travelling via Kasane in northern Botswana and Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe to clear immigration formalities, your next stop is Linkwasha Camp in Hwange National Park for 2 nights.

Day 11 – November departures end after Hwange: Private charter from Linkwasha Camp via Bulawayo to clear immigration formalities to O.R.Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg, South Africa, for your onward arrangements.

All other departures include a further 2 nights at Ruckomechi Camp as below:

Day 11 – Private charter from Linkwasha to Ruckomechi Camp in Mana Pools for 2 nights.

Day 13 – Private charter from Ruckomechi Camp via Bulawayo to clear immigration formalities back to O.R.Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg, South Africa, for your onward arrangements.

INCLUSIONS:

- All accommodation, all meals, twice daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry and all local drinks - excludes premium imported brands and champagne.
- Private charter flight in a Pilatus from pick up at O.R. Tambo International Airport to drop off on final day at O.R. Tambo International Airport.
- Services of a qualified pilot guide to accompany the group throughout the trip.
- Private vehicles are included at all Wilderness Safaris camps.
- Scheduled crayfish lunch excursion at Swakopmund with transfers to and from Swakopmund Airport.
- Services of the camp/lodge guides and staff.
- Relevant park fees and entrance fees as specified in the quote.
- Laundry is included at the Wilderness Safaris camps specified in the itinerary.
- Accommodation taxes, the applicable Tourism Levies and all relevant Value Added Tax (VAT) or Government Sales Tax (GST).

GENERAL EXCLUSIONS:

- Any drinks, park fees, entrance fees, porterage, tours/excursions and transfers not specified in the quote.
- All international and domestic passenger departure taxes are not included and are
 payable by the guests directly.
- Cancellation, baggage and medical insurance.

NOTES:

- Accommodation has been reserved in 5 twin rooms throughout (single supplement applies)
- Luggage, including camera equipment and hand luggage, is restricted to 20 kg (44 lb) per person travelling on seat rates.
- Only soft bags will be accepted no frames or rigid structures can be transported as they physically cannot fit into the aircraft. Wheels on a bag are only permissible if they are not part of a solid frame or rigid structure. The maximum dimensions of the soft bags which can be accommodated are as follows: 25 cm (10 inches) wide x 30 cm (12 inches) high and 62 cm (24 inches) long.
