

# A RAILWAY ADVENTURE

## with Hwange or Livingstone

The first adventure includes two nights on the train, enjoying the luxury that Rovos Rail is renowned for, before disembarking at Hwange National Park for three nights at a Wilderness Safaris camp and some of the best wildlife viewing on offer. Alternatively, after spending three nights on the train, the second journey arrives in Victoria Falls where you are met and taken on a tour of the Falls themselves, before crossing the border into Zambia for two nights at either the African-inspired Toka Leya or the elegant and recently-refurbished River Club!

## A Railway Adventure with Hwange

### Brief Itinerary

- Day 1:** The train departs Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria and travels through the old goldfields of Johannesburg to Mafikeng, to clear Botswana border formalities.  
*Lunch & Dinner & Overnight: Rovos Rail*
- Day 2:** Head north-west through Gaborone and Plumtree, clearing Zimbabwe border formalities en-route.  
*Full Board & Overnight: Rovos Rail*
- Day 3:** Travel along the eastern edge of Hwange National Park on one of Africa's longest stretches of straight railway line – 114 kilometres. Arrive at Intundhla siding in the afternoon and disembark for your game drive-transfer through Hwange National Park to Little Makalolo Camp (or Linkwasha Camp from 01 May 2015).  
*Breakfast & Lunch: Rovos Rail*  
*Dinner & Overnight: Little Makalolo Camp / Linkwasha Camp*
- Day 4 & 5:** Enjoy two scheduled daily activities at Little Makalolo Camp / Linkwasha Camp.  
*Full Board & Overnight: Little Makalolo Camp / Linkwasha Camp*
- Day 6:** Light aircraft transfer from Hwange to Victoria Falls for your onward travel arrangements.

## Brief Itinerary

**Day 1:** The train departs Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria and travels through the old goldfields of Johannesburg to Mafikeng, to clear Botswana border formalities.

**Lunch & Dinner & Overnight: Rovos Rail**

**Day 2:** Head north-west through Gaborone and Plumtree, clearing Zimbabwe border formalities en-route.

**Full Board & Overnight: Rovos Rail**

**Day 3:** Travel along the eastern edge of Hwange National Park on one of Africa's longest stretches of straight railway line – 114 kilometres. Arrive at Kennedy siding in the afternoon for a game drive at The Hide before returning to the train.

**Full Board & Overnight: Rovos Rail**

**Day 4:** Arrive at Victoria Falls station in the morning. Transfer to the Falls for a private tour before proceeding to the border to clear Zimbabwe and Zambia immigration formalities. Collection on the Zambian side and private road transfer to either Toka Leya or The River Club (approximately 25 minutes).

**Breakfast: Rovos Rail**

**Lunch & Dinner & Overnight: Toka Leya or The River Club**

**Day 5:** Scheduled lodge activities at Toka Leya or The River Club.

**Full Board & Overnight: Toka Leya or The River Club**

**Day 6:** Private road transfer to Livingstone Airport for your onward travel arrangements.
