Situated at the heart of the Albertine Rift, Rwanda is one of Africa's most biodiverse regions and a haven of rainforest endemism. The undulating hills and mountains of the rainforest on the western peaks give way to wetland and savannah in the east.

Rwanda's most celebrated wild mammal is the magnificent mountain gorilla found in the Virunga Massif, amongst a host of other rainforest species. However, less known is the incredible scenery and thriving wildlife of Akagera National Park, where the likes of lion, leopard and buffalo roam.

Day 1: Kigali Serena Hotel

### Day 4 & 5: Bisate Lodge

Bisate offers dramatic views of the peaks of the Bisoke and Karisimbi volcanoes rearing up through Afro-alpine forests. Six opulent ensuite forest villas maximise comfort and the views, while adhering to environmentally responsible principles and reflecting the rich culture of rural Rwanda.

The lodge is within easy driving distance of Volcanoes National Park Headquarters, from where gorilla treks depart daily. Nature walks and cultural participation are also on offer.
