

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
A TASTE OF THE DELTA








DIVERSITY OF WILDLIFE

Variety is the thrill of life. Vumbura's myriad ecosystems support almost every species found in the Delta, and many that are found in few other places. Every activity becomes a journey of discovery as you watch the fierce interactions between predator and prey, or spy a rare sable or Pel's fishing-owl.







The waterlily (locally known as tswii) is a multi-use food-source for local people. The main stem, or rhizome, is pounded into a flour-like powder, which is used to make pancakes, pasta or Mma Glo's Tswii, a delicious stew.
