





Botswana Explorations











Great Wilderness Journey 10 nights / 11 days This Exploration runs between May and November

Encounter the world-famous Victoria Falls and explore Botswana's scenic northern areas: from the blue-green wetlands of the Okavango Delta to the Linyanti and Chobe River systems renowned for their predators and large concentrations of game.

Botswana Summer Encounter

10 nights / 11 days This Exploration runs between November and December 2017

Explore the life-filled Central Kalahari Game Reserve, the fertile green islands and wildlife-rich floodplains of the Okavango Delta, a cruise down Chobe River, and a grand finale of the world-famous Victoria Falls – all in one of its most abundant and remarkable seasons.

Okavango Channels and Plains

6 nights / 7 days This Exploration runs between November and April

Set out to explore the wildlife-rich savannahs of the Santawani Concession in the southeastern corner of the Okavango and the floodplains and waterways in the heart of the Delta in the warm summer months. Marked by the life-giving rains, the season heralds the profusion of new life of both fauna and flora.

Into the Wilderness Botswana 6 nights / 7 days This Exploration runs between June and October

Exploring two unique wilderness areas that have been shaped by the southernmost fault lines of Africa's Great Rift Valley, this safari begins in the pristine Xigera concession at a true water camp on a remote island deep in the Okavango Delta. We then discover the lush riverine woodlands of the Linyanti River and its wildlife-filled floodplains.

The Trans-Okavango 9 nights /10 days 21 - 30 July 2017 (only one departure)

This unique and exclusive Exploration captures the essence of the Okavango and the spirit of exploration on land, water and in the air. It visits the prime game-viewing areas of Hunda Island, Mombo and Chitabe combined with the iconic water experiences offered at Pelo and Xigera. Guests have the rare opportunity to walk, boat and fly from one camp to the other, as well as enjoy the thrill of flying over the Delta in a helicopter.

Diverse Namibia 9 nights / 10 days

This Exploration runs year-round

Travelling on lesser known routes, this is a true adventure that takes in the soaring red dunes of Sossusvlei, the life-filled blue Atlantic Ocean, the desert and denizens of Damaraland, and the plains game and predators of Etosha National Park.

Desert Dune Safari

9 nights / 10 days This Exploration runs between May and mid-November

This safari takes you through some of the most remote areas on this planet, beginning at the dunes of Sossusvlei and exploring the marine life off Swakopmund. We then discover the dramatic and secluded coastline of the Skeleton Coast and the desolate landscape of Namibia's starkly beautiful north-west.

Hwange Walking Safari 4 nights / 5 days This Exploration runs between July and September

Set out under the African sun and explore Hwange's most abundant concession on foot and by vehicle. Found in the south-eastern corner of Zimbabwe's largest National Park, our private Linkwasha Concession's diverse range of habitats is a magnet for a variety of wildlife.
